## COMBINE GOLF WITH GASTRONOMY & WELLNESS THIS EASTER AT ARGENTARIO GOLF RESORT & SPA

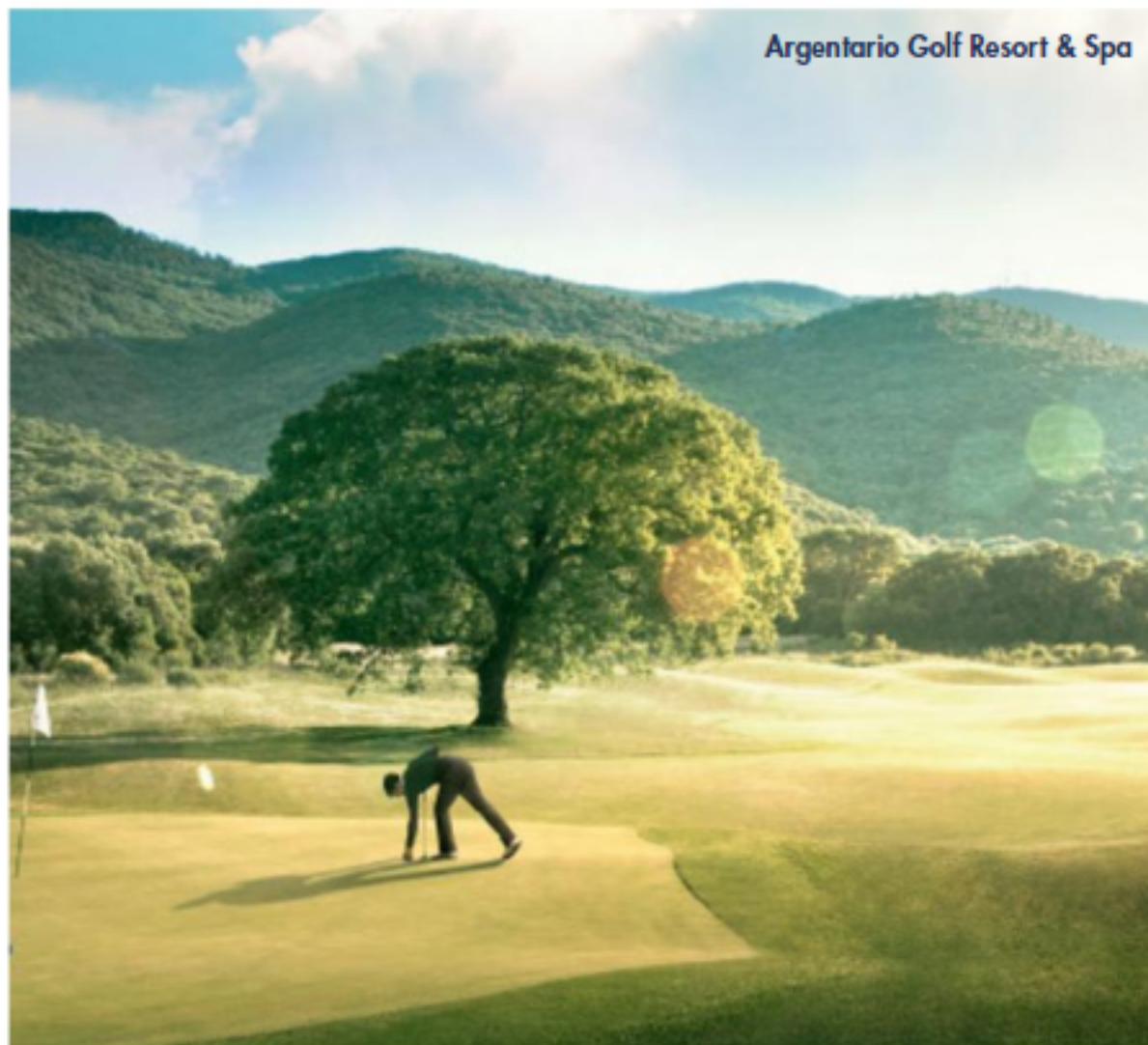
